6. Old Business

- Kent looked into a couple HOA items:

--Street Lights, cost and maintenance: spoke to city engineers and Mayor's office, has partial information so far: city maintains a small amount of street lights, most are maintained by Northwestern Energy and paid for by additional charges as an additional type of property tax special improvement district by the residents that live in the "Lighting Districts". The Pleasant View street lights became property of the HOA when the city annexed Pleasant View. Ken is still waiting to hear back from city with additional information.

--Sidewalks: as per municipal code, sidewalk maintenance is the responsibility of the property owner of the adjacent property. City states that they have a special financing option for homeowners that need to repair sidewalks.
