### REMINDER ABOUT SNOW REMOVAL

We have many new Homeowners/Renters this year so we want to again mention the guidelines for when the HOA will remove snow on sidewalks and alleyways. Snow will be removed on the sidewalks in front of the HOA member's homes at 1.5 inches and 4 inches in the alleys. We will remove ice and use ice melt around the mail boxes.

Please note that the HOA is only responsible for maintaining HOA-owned sidewalks. Snow and Ice removal is ultimately the responsibility of the homeowner/renter. City regulations indicate that snow should be removed the day after the event by 9 a.m. The HOA contractor will not plow while it is snowing and will only plow once per day.

### **BUILD MULLAN**

We have all been watching Mary Jane Boulevard, both North and South, and England West with interest and some trepidation as it will increase the traffic through our neighborhood substantially. These plans for MaryJane & England have been in the master plan for our area from the onset, so PLEASE remember to be a good neighbor and watch your speed!

This past year, numerous instances of vandalism have occurred in the neighborhood. The individuals that have damaged our sprinkler systems and signs have cost our HOA several thousand dollars. In addition, our neighborhood has had a number of break-ins or attempted break-ins. BE WATCHFUL - If you see something - say something!
