Just Some Notes...

• Please remember we live in the City Limits and there is a Leash Law. When walking your dog, it must be on a leash.

•If you have a greenway behind your home please check for any dog messes and remove them. This is not part of our lawn care provider's responsibility.

•Please clean up around your home and yard. Keep your lawn watered.

•The HOA will be turning on our water in parks and greenways sometime in June.

•We have noticed that there is a lot of rising and falling of some sidewalks. The HOA will take care of the Handicap down areas of sidewalks. We also will be taking care of the property the HOA owns. The Homeowner is responsible for the sidewalks in front of and/or side of your property. The last couple of years we have used a company by the name of Mud Jacking at 543-1210 for leveling repair. There may be others.

Street Sweeping Schedule



Our neighborhood is scheduled for April $11^{th} - 26^{th}$ and June $2th - July 5^{th}$. Please park on the odd number side of the street on odd days and the even number side on even days. Do not put piles of leaves in the street. The street division only picks up leaves in the fall.

It is Spring Time!

Along with spring comes a fresh crop of Dandelions! It is important to treat the little weeds that are so colorful. A lawn service can help but products like Scotts Turf Builder Weed n Feed (which is a dry product), Spectracide Weed Stop or Ortho Weed Be Gone (which is a spray) also do the job.

Note: Digging them out doesn't work and seems to stimulate growth!

Recreational Vehicles, RV's, Boats, etc.
