Neighborhood Watch Program

These type of vehicles are only permitted to be on the street or in your driveway for not more than 48 hours. They are not permitted to block the sidewalk in any way. NEVER place an extension cord across a sidewalk. This is a violation and can be reported to the City Police.

JUST SOME REMINDERS

- ➤ Please remember we live in the City and there is a Leash Law. When walking your dog it must be on a leash.
- We have several Dog Stations throughout the neighborhood, please remember to clean up your dog's messes. This is not part of the lawn care provider's responsibility.
- > Now is the time to clean up around your home and yard. Please keep your lawn watered.
- > The HOA will be turning on the water in parks and greenways soon.
- ➤ Our neighborhood is famous for Dandelion populations. It is very important to treat the little weeds as soon as they start coming up. Digging them up doesn't work and seems to stimulate growth.
- > If you have a vehicle that is not working, it must be stored in your driveway or garage and not parked on the street. If left in the street, they will be tagged for removal by the city.

Street Sweeping Schedule



Our area is scheduled for April 10th though May 1st, and August 4th through the 21st.

Even-Numbered Days: Park on the even numbered side of the street from 7:00a.m .until 3:00p.m . Odd-Numbered Days: Park on the odd numbered side of the street from 7:00a.m .until 3:00p.m .

NOTE: The street division only picks up leaves in the fall.
