SOMETHING NEW


Beginning in July we have a few volunteers that will be walking the neighborhood looking for homes to receive recognition for the Best Lawn and the Best Landscaping. We will ask permission before putting signage in front of the homes. The signs will be moved to a different home after a week or two. During July, August and September we will keep track of which homeowners were recognized and give an award in each category at the end of September.

TREES ON THE BOULEVARD

At the May 21st meeting Marie Anderson, Urban Forester for the City, brought the Board up to the current standards for care and maintenance of the boulevard trees. Water and fertilizing the boulevard trees is the homeowner's responsibility. Any other actions: insect spraying, clearance or decorative pruning, removal and/or planting must be first coordinated with the Urban Forester. The City has a plan for monitoring, rating and scheduling tree removal and replacements at no cost to the homeowner. Also, be aware that the HOA has a City approved volunteer on call, which will save you time and expense.

IMPROVEMENTS TO OUR SUBDIVISION THIS SPRING

There is a new sign and new landscaping in our England Boulevard roundabout. It looks so fresh and nice!

We have set two new Doggy Waste Stations and two new trash cans in the park on Fleet and Manchester and at the corner of Camden and Stratford.

All of the Time Clocks in our sprinkler systems have been replaced and updated and all of the broken ball valves have been replaced.

Just Some Notes

1. Please remember that there is a Leash Law in the City limits. When walking or running with your dog, they must be on a leash!

2. Please pick up after your dog goes poop.

3. Please remember that if the sidewalk in front of your home is rising or falling and someone could trip, you can call Mud Jacking; they did the HOA walkways last year. Their phone number is 543-1210.

4. Summer is finally here; your trailers cannot be parked or stored for more than 48 hours in front of your home. This is a Covenant requirement – after 120 hours or 5 days the City can be called to tag your RV.

5. If you live on an alleyway or walkway, you are responsible for the upkeep in the area behind and/or beside your fence.
